Job Title: Larvicide Technician

Job Description: Surveillance/Larvacide Tech: Full Time, est. 30 – 40 hrs a week. 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday. Primarily field work, involving GIS/GPS, tablet data entry, walking, detecting and treating mosquito larvae in standing water. Must be capable of carrying/operating 45-50lb backpacks, operate ATV's and other applications - good driving record required. If you are applying for this position please include a copy of your driving record with your application.

Equipment: Should be able to operate basic hand and power tools, droid operated tablet, motor vehicle, side-by-side ATV, amphibian ATV, hand held dry and liquid spraying devices

Physical Demands: The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an individual to successfully perform essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- 1. Wear common protective or Safety Equipment such as Safety Shoes, Glasses, Gloves, Hearing Protection, High Visualization clothing when exposed to chemicals, contaminants, or variable weather conditions
- 2. Ability to occasionally lift items in excess of 40 pounds
