Acceptance form with the Designated Election Official no later than 3:00 p.m. Friday February 24, 2023.

- 5. If the only matter before the electors is the election of Directors of the District and if, at the close of business on Tuesday February 28, 2023, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at the election, including write-in candidates timely filing affidavits of intent no later than February 27, 2023, the Designated Election Official shall cancel the election and declare candidates elected. Notice of such cancellation shall be published and posted in accordance with the Code. This notice and this resolution, signed by the Board Chair, shall be filed with the Division of Local Government.
- 6. Pursuant to Section 1-11-203.5, C.R.S., any election contest arising out of a ballot question concerning the order of the ballot or the form or content of the ballot shall be commenced by petition filed with the proper court within five (5) days after the title of the ballot question is set.
- 7. If any part or provision of this Resolution is adjudged to be unenforceable or invalid, such judgement shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remaining provisions of this Resolution, it being the Board's intention that the various provisions hereof are severable.
- 8. Any and all actions previously taken by the Designated Election official or the Secretary of the Board of Directors or any other persons acting in their behalf pursuant to the Act, the Code, or other applicable laws, and hereby ratified and confirmed.
- 9. All acts, orders, and resolutions, or parts thereof, of the Board which are inconsistent or in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency or conflict.

10. The provisions of this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
